TRUCK PERMITS

Louisiana requires that a certificate of insurance, which insures any damage to state property, must be posted at the Truck Permit Office before any permit will be issued. The amount of coverage required is a minimum of \$100,000. Automobile liability coverage is required for truck and trailer; Off-road units require general liability coverage.

The Acord certificate must be attached in a PDF and should show the effective date, expiration date, property damage coverage and the insurance contact (name and phone number). This must be entered by customers in management tab under insurance.

Escort vehicles must have general liability insurance, motor vehicle insurance and workers' compensation each providing for a minimum of \$500,000.00 in coverage (revised statute 387.1 [b]). At this time the Truck Permit Office is not requiring proof of workers' compensation until further notice.
