General Discussion

Bike-Ped Mater Plan 2024 Updates

Assessment for pedestrian facilities – Will be updated every four years.

The update will look back at the previous four years in order to come up with ways to implement complete streets infrastructure for the next four years.

3 components to implementation:

- 1. Sponsorships
- 2. Funding
- 3. Connectivity

Plan will be posted as a GIS map. The focus is on local streets. The plan is not fixed yet and will be continuously updated.

These implementations will work in the following categories:

- 1. Low volume/slow speed facility's safe and comfortable to ride a bicycle on the street in the traffic lanes with vehicles
- 2. On road bike facilities/ Off Road Trails. Require right of way for bikers.
- Vision Project (Comprehensive Projects)
 Example: LSU Lakes- includes widening of I-10, drenching of lakes, bicycle pedestrian facilities, boardwalks, etc...

Funding for projects is a challenge, but the IIJA grant money should provide more funds.

As stated previously, connectivity of the network is a major component of the plan. An critical area of focus should be over bus stops. CATS is looking to consolidate many of its stops, but connectivity of the stops with the ped/bike network is still an issue. CATS is also updating its stops to be ADA compliant.

Other Business:

Bayou Bike & Hike Southwest Louisiana Trail Network Discussion

Indented to eventually be a complete streets plan

- Survey for public comment. Posted on GIS
- Covers 5 parishes of Southwest Louisiana
- Feedback needed if anyone would like to propose a bike or pedestrian trail within region. Visit mpo.planswla.com.
- Bayou Greenbelt Discussion
 - This is a new Canoe and kayak trail that has a GIS map.
- New Orleans NORPC is doing a Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) plan for Tangipahoa, St. Tammany, and Saint John Parishes. There is a separate New Orleans SS4A Planning grant.
- SS4A discussion
 - Could invite entities to come talk about these SS4A
 - Could possibly have a ½ day workshop to collect information and discuss challenges
- Steering Group Update:

The group will figure out individual goals and create measureable that will be used. The group will seek feedback from CSAC through this process.

• Order Of Business:
