Directive: 1

- 1. **PURPOSE**. The purpose of this directive is to establish uniform policy concerning documenting delays caused by utility conflicts on projects that are under contract.
- 2. **SCOPE.** This directive establishes guidelines for documenting delays caused by utility conflicts.
- 3. **PROCEDURE**. For each utility conflict the following information will be recorded in the Project Diary.
- a) Location and elevation (approximately)
- b) Type of utility and owner
- c) Contractor's operation that is being delayed
- d) Length of time of the delay
- e) Was Contractor shut down by the utility conflict
- f) Was Contractor's operation shifted to new location (give new location)
- g) Brief description of action taken to resolve conflict
- h) Itemize equipment idled because of the conflict
- i) Itemize labor idled if labor remains on project on payroll

If the delay continues or if there is a series of delays caused by one or more utilities, the above information will also be furnished this office by letter.

- 4. **OTHER ISSUANCES AFFECTED**. This directive supersedes EDSM No. 111.3.1.1, dated June 24, 1985. All other directives, memoranda or instructions heretofore which conflict with this directive are hereby rescinded.
