All Local, Municipal and Parish Authorities

Gentlemen:

Section 235 of Act 310 of the 1962 Legislature states that the Department of Highways "shall adopt a manual and specifications for a uniform system of traffic control devices . . . for use upon highways within this State. Such uniform system shall correlate with and so far as possible conform to the system then current as approved by the American Association of State Highway Officials."

It further states "Local, municipal and parish authorities in their respective jurisdictions shall place and maintain such traffic control devices upon highways under their jurisdictions as they may deem necessary to indicate and to carry out the provisions of this Chapter, regulations of this Department and the Director of Public Safety adopted pursuant hereto, and local traffic ordinances adopted pursuant to the authority granted by Sections 41 and 42 of this Chapter. All such traffic control devices hereafter erected shall conform to the Department's manual and specifications."

To fulfill the Department's responsibility, the following manual has been prepared and it is officially designated as the Department's manual of traffic control devices.

This copy of the manual is forwarded you so that your engineers, when installing traffic control devices, can conform with the provisions of Act 310.
