SUBJECT: New Traffic Signal Policy

The Office of Engineering and the Office of Operations jointly set a new state policy as follows:

All new traffic signals and all upgraded traffic signals via either construction project, permit or in house staff shall have accessible pedestrian signals and detectors installed if a sidewalk with tactile warnings are in place.

This policy shall go into effect July 1, 2020 for all construction projects and all maintenance work. In order for this to be effective, the following must occur by June 30, 2020.

- 1. The Traffic Engineering Division shall update all policies pertaining to signalized pedestrian crossings in the Traffic Signal Design Manual and the Traffic Engineering Manual.
- 2. Traffic Services shall prepare a maintenance specification for purchasing this equipment for in house upgrades and installations.
- 3. Contracts and Specifications shall get an accessible pedestrian signal specification approved for use in construction projects.
- 4. Once installed, District staff shall inspect these signals on a quarterly basis to ensure all equipment at the signal is operating effectively. If it is not working, maintenance shall be done to ensure proper functionality. The inspection shall be documented.

SUBJECT: Updated Traffic Signal Policy for APS

The Office of Engineering and the Office of Operations jointly update the Traffic Signal Policy for APS as follows:

All new traffic signals and all upgraded traffic signals via either construction project, permit or in house staff shall have audible pedestrian signals and detectors if the DOTD Traffic Engineering Manual Section 3B.2 is met for Marked Crosswalks.

This policy shall be effective immediately.
