Discussion Summary

- Railroads near highways may need more “DO NOT STOP ON TRACKS” signs to be added, etc.
- Stop or yield signs to be added to the Crossbucks at Passive Public Crossing (called Crossbuck Assemblies)
- If DOTD closes a public crossing by our process, there is a special DOTD “TO BE CLOSED” sign to be used
- Railroad Preemption, possible blank out turn restriction signs can be used
- Remember if your job crosses a railroad, do NOT ignore the RR.
