For Safety's Sake Please Observe

THESE HIGHWAY LAWS

- Do not exceed the following statutory speed limits:
 - Rural areas 60 miles per hour
 - Automobiles 53 miles per hour
 - Buses 45 miles per hour
 - Trucks 45 miles per hour
- All Vehicles 25 miles per hour

All Vehicles 25 miles per hour is reasonable and prudent with regard for existing conditions. Do not drive while under influence of intoxicants or narcotics. Do not pass school bus while taking on or discharging passengers. Do not drive unless you have a driver's license (except residents of states not requiring a license).

THESE SAFETY SUGGESTIONS

Keep to the right of the center line, except while passing. Don't overdrive the reach of your headlights at night. Let the other fellow know what you are going to do — SIGNAL.

Dim your headlights when meeting another vehicle.

REPORT OF ACCIDENTS

The law requires that the driver of any motor vehicle involved in an accident resulting in the death or injury of any person, or property damage in the amount of \$25.00 or more shall, within 24 hours, make a report of such accident to the State Police, or if the accident happens in a city, to the police department of that city.
