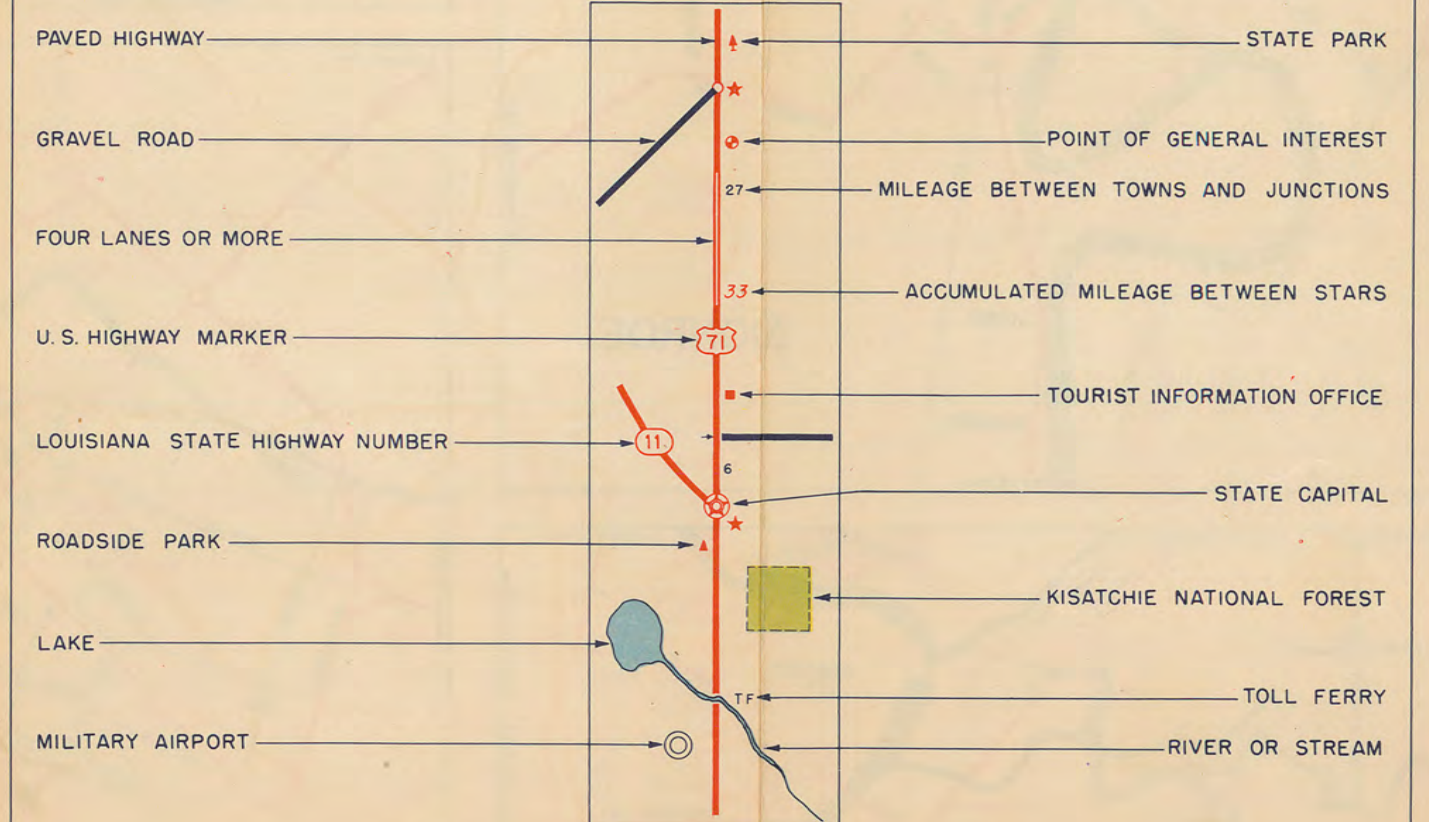


MAP EXPLANATION
