





Bass-fishing for the big ones in Lake Bisteneau — flyrod, spinning reel, casting or cane pole — is a rewarding experience during most of the year.



Hodges Gardens, operated by a non-profit foundation, is one of Louisiana's beauty spots. Above, red-white-and-blue hyacinths in a formal setting.




Morove Pine grows beautifully and profitably near Urania, and is a handsome setting for camping, picnicking and nature-study trips all the year long.




Historic Jackson Square in New Orleans is the center of tourist interest in the colorful background of Louisiana's heritage, shrine of a bygone era.




Four thousand acres of natural and man-made beauty surround this Azalea center at Hodges Gardens near Many, for year-round scenic splendor.




Good fishing is one of the greatest attractions Louisiana offers to the year-round vacationist . . . bayous, streams, lakes and the Gulf of Mexico.




Hot Wells Health Resort, near Alexandria, is state-owned . . . a mineral spa offering health-giving baths, swimming, boating, fishing and relaxation.

Fish and game of all kinds abound in Anacoco State Game and Fish Preserve, easy to get to for recreation throughout the year in western Louisiana.





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For Safety's Sake

PLEASE OBSERVE

THESE HIGHWAY LAWS

- Do not exceed the following statutory speed limits:

Rural areas	
Automobiles	60 miles per hour*
Buses	60 miles per hour
Trucks	45 miles per hour
*45 miles per hour on 4 lane highways.	
Built up areas	
All vehicles	25 miles per hour.

Do not drive at a speed greater than is reasonable and prudent with regard for existing conditions.
Do not drive while under influence of intoxicants or narcotics.
Do not pass school bus while taking on or discharging passengers.
Do not drive unless you have a driver's license (except residents of states not requiring a license).



- Keep to the right of the center line, except while passing.
Don't overdrive the reach of your headlights at night.
Let the other fellow know what you are going to do — SIGNAL.
Dim your headlights when meeting another vehicle.

REPORT OF ACCIDENTS

The law requires that the driver of any motor vehicle involved in an accident resulting in the death or injury of any person, or property damage in the apparent estimate of \$25.00 or more shall, within 24 hours, make a report of such accident to the State Police, or if the accident happens in a city, to the police department of that city.
