**RE: DBE Goal Setting
Fiscal Year 2023-2025**

Dear Mr. Patrick:

Attached is the revised 2023-2025 DBE Goal Methodology. The Louisiana Department of Transportation has established a goal of 1.37% of which 1.37% is Race Neutral and 0% is Race Conscious for the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) for the FY 2023- 2025. This goal encompasses DBE utilization as prime contractors and consultants, as well as subcontractors on FTA funded projects. Also, enclosed is the DBE Goal Setting Methodology explanation report for your information, review, and approval.

The methodology used to calculate the LADOTD's DBE Goal was based on the 2020 Economic Census – County Business Patterns for Louisiana and the LADOTD's UCP Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Directory to determine our base figure. Of the 7119 firms, 152 are DBE contractors in Louisiana.

In determining the DBE goal, DOTD took into consideration all prime contracts and subcontractors performed by DBE contractors which were obtained without the benefit of goal requirements. Analysis of the past participation by our DBE community confirms that an overall DBE goal in excess of 1.37% would not be reasonable target in Louisiana. A full explanation and calculation are included.

FISCAL YEAR 2023-2025**

This document explains the methodology used by our department to establish our fiscal year 2023-2025 DBE goal.

GOAL SETTING METHODOLOGY 49 CFR PART 26.45

The federal regulations require recipients to set overall goals based on demonstrative evidence of availability of ready, willing and able DBEs relative to all businesses ready, willing and able to participate on DOT assisted contracts.

A. Step 1 Base Figure Determination 26.45(c)

1. The Louisiana DOTD elected to use the 2020 Economic Census – County Business Patterns for Louisiana and LADOTD’s UCP Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Directory to determine our base figure. In Step One of the goal setting process, contractible items were identified and a weighted average figured for each item.
2. The Base Goal was figured using the relative availability (percentage) of DBEs in Louisiana to perform contracts (both prime and sub) scheduled for FFYs 2023 – 2025. Of the 7119 firms, 152 are DBE contractors in Louisiana. Utilizing this information, we arrived at a base figure of 1.37%, included in Table 3.
3. In Table 1, the projects are identified by the NAICS Code, amount of DOT funds for project, and % of total DOT funds for each project. The estimated project cost is \$24,189,343. The amount for each project was divided by the total estimated cost of \$24,189,343 to determine the weight factor for each project to be used in Table 3 below.

$$\frac{\text{Amount of DOT funds on Project}}{\text{Total FTA-Assisted Contract Funds}} = \text{Weight}$$

In Table 2, the number of ready, willing, and able DBEs are identified for each NAICS codes to determine the relative availability of DBEs.

$$\frac{\text{Number of DBEs Availability}}{\text{Number of all firms}} = \text{Relative Availability}$$

In Table 3, the weighted base figure was determined by using the weight for each project multiplied by the relative availability which resulted in the Weighted Base Figure of 1.37%.

$$(Weight) \times (Relative\ Availability) = Base\ Figure$$

B. Step 2 Adjustment Factors 26.45(d)

LADOTD used the goal setting guidelines, “Tips for Goal-Setting in the DBE Program, from the USDOT website which includes a method for determining an adjustment based on past participation for the years in which participation is similar to the type of contracts for the goal methodology period. LADOTD used the five completed years of past participation (see Table 4) in computing the median value. The Median DBE participation in FTA-funded contracts from FY 2017 through 2021 was 1.82%

Using this method (1.82%) and our base figure (1.37%) resulted in a goal of 1.51%.

$$\text{Adjusted Goal} = \frac{(\text{Base Figure} + \text{Median DBE})}{2}$$

$$1.37\% + 1.82\% = 3.19\%$$

$$\frac{3.19\%}{2} = 1.59\% \text{ Adjusted Goal}$$

Thus, LADOTD has determined that an adjustment for past participation is not necessary due to the levels of past participation being very similar to the number calculated in Step One Base Figure.

LADOTD proposed goal for FTA DBE is 1.37%

A disparity study was conducted by the City of Baton Rouge Metropolitan government in 2019. However, the study was based on local data relevant to the geographical boundaries of the Parish of East Baton Rouge. The data does not take into account the other regions of the state of Louisiana. Effectively eliminating over two-thirds of the geographic market of the LADOTD. Therefore, LADOTD did not consider evidence from disparity studies as part of its step two analysis. Other related data on employment,

self-employment, education and training, union apprenticeship programs, etc. of the kind described in 49CFR 26.45(d) does not exist and consequently was not considered as part of the step two analysis.

C. Public Consultation 26.45 (g)

1. LADOTD conducted public consultation forums where all interested stakeholders, including our DBE firms; the contracting community, AGC, minority and women organizations, and other interested parties were invited. These two public consultation forums were held on May 24, 2022 in the auditorium of DOTD headquarters in Baton Rouge, and the second on May 26, 2022 in Shreveport. Information relative to our public consultation process is in Attachment A. No comments were received.
2. On May 25, 2022, our DBE goal and contact information for viewing our methodology was posted on our department's website and in the lobby our headquarters building. It was also published for a public comment period of over 30 days through June 8, 2022, throughout the State of Louisiana to all subscribers of the MyDOTD application, and it was also published in the following newspapers around the state: The Alexandria Town Talk, Bossier Press Tribune, Lafayette Daily Advertiser, Lake Charles American Press, The Advocate-Acadiana, The Advocate-Baton Rouge, The Advocate-New Orleans and The Shreveport Times, shown in Attachment B. No comments were received.
3. Information relative to our public consultation process and advertisement efforts is included in Attachment A & B. A screen shot of our website posting with the link is included in Attachment B.

D. Race Neutral Measures 26.51(a)

1. The regulations require that the state must meet maximum feasible portion of its overall goal by using race and gender neutral means of facilitating DBE participation. LADOTD has determined all goals will be accomplished through race neutral means. The calculation of race neutral goal is based upon contracting opportunities, past participation, relative availability of DBEs. These calculations resulted in a goal of 1.51%. This is based upon the median of accomplishments of the past 5 years: 2017 – 0%; 2018 – 1.82%; 2019 – 5.25%; 2020 – 2.1%; and 2021 – 0.67%
