Please accept the following amendments to FY 2011 Transit Element of the Regional Planning Commission's Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for the New Orleans UZAs, for inclusion in the State Transportation Improvement Plan.

The amendment concerns the reduction of \$80,000 from both the preventive maintenance and the planning line items for RTA. RTA will reallocate the \$80,000 to two new items: Security Training and Solar Panel/Shelter Upgrades. All of these changes concern 2011 Section 5307 funding, and the amendment demonstrates the required 20% matches.
