Please accept the most recently amended Transit Element of the Baton Rouge Metropolitan Planning Organization's FY 2019 – FY 2022 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The changes below were approved by the Capital Region MPO Policy Committee on June 17, 2020.

FY 2019 - 2022 Transit Element Modifications

Changed the formatting of the transit element of the TIP. The new transit element includes an apportionment year and TIP year. The apportionment year is the FY in which the funds were given to the transit entity. The TIP year is the FY when the money is planned to be spent. Sometimes funds cannot be fully spent in the year in which they are apportioned. When this occurs, the money can be moved to a different TIP year. The new formatting follows the money from initial apportionment to the FY in which all the money is spent. Additionally, the new format eliminated the FY breakdown. Funding is now shown as one table and spending year can be seen as TIP Year.

FY 2018 - FTA 5339

- Repurpose \$24k federal funds of carryover previously programmed for Associated Transit Enhancements to Plank Road BRT North Transfer Center.

FY 2020 - CMAQ Funds

- Requested a transfer of \$1,730,904 federal funds (\$2,163,630 total with \$432,726 in local funds) from FHWA Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) funds to FTA for use in procuring three (3) electric buses. This request was approved and is now being added to the TIP.

FY 2020 - STP>200K Funds

- Adding \$1,000,000 in STP>200K federal funds (\$1,200,000 total with \$200,000 in local funds) apportioned in December 2019 to the TIP as Associated Transit Enhancements. MPO Board approved the transfer of funds from Associated Transit Enhancements to North Transfer Center. This funding will be added to the TIP as North Transfer Center contingent upon DOTD approval.

FY 2020 - FTA 5310/5311

- Added FY 2020 5310/5311 funding allocation to the TIP.

FY 2020 CARES ACT

- Added \$17.65 million in funding to the TIP resulting from COVID-19 mitigation efforts.

FY 2019 BUILD Grant

- Added \$15 million in funding to the TIP for Plank Road BRT project.

Please also see attached the FY 2019-2022 Transit TIP projects, which will replace the previous version in its entirety. The new amendments will support the regional TAM targets set by CRPC (MPO) in coordination with LADOTD and CATS. The percent of revenue vehicles and equipment that have met or exceeded their useful life will decrease there by making the operations more efficient. I have attached a copy of the Amendment XIII to Lake Charles Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) document. The amendment is an update to the Transit Element section of the TIP FY 2019 -22 period for FY 21. The transit update represents the use of Coronavirus Aid, Relief, And Economic Security (CARES) Act operating funds for Calcasieu Parish Public Transit (5311 and 5316) and Calcasieu Voluntary Council on Aging (5310).

The grant utilizes 100% Fed Share of the CAREs ACT in FY 21 for both Calcasieu Parish Public Transit (\$200,000 for 5311 Rural; \$75,000 for 5316 Rural – JARC; and \$100K for 5316 Urban – JARC) and Calcasieu Parish Council on Aging (\$60,000 on 5310 Small Urban), added to the TIP as Amendment XIII.

Regarding the State of Good Repair performance measures of the LaDOTD Transit Asset Management (TAM) Plan, the CARES Act operating funds would contribute to continued use of equipment, rolling stock, and facilities at these agencies through the life cycle of these assets. In conjunction with enhancing passenger experience through a comprehensive inventory and assessment of assets, new operating funds help to improve routes and service throughout the system.

The Technical Advisory Committee recommended Amendment XIII, under Resolution #2157, for approval on July 16th, 2020. The Transportation Policy Committee adopted Amendment XIII to the TIP on July 16th, 2020. The Public Review period was held from July 3rd – July 16th, and on July 16th the final Public Hearing was held, where the amendment was approved.

Amendment XIII will be added as #27 in the Record of Adoptions and Amendments, as seen below.

Please accept these most recent amendments to the Transit Element of the Regional Planning Commission's FY 20 Transportation Improvement Programs (TIP) for both the New Orleans and Tangipahoa UZAs.

In New Orleans, the Regional Transit Authority was awarded a Mobility for All grant (Sect. 3006(b) FAST Act), to be used for the "Moving New Orleans East" project. This project was previously listed in the TIP as "pending award."

In Tangipahoa, the Parish has decided to switch funding from 5307 to CARES Act funding for two projects: bus fleet expansion and parking facility construction. As per the provisions of the CARES Act, local match is waived for both of these projects.

Neither of these projects has an impact on Transit Asset Management measures. The Policy Board and Commission approved these amendments on July 14, 2020. If you have any questions or need additional information, please let me know.
