Please accept the most recently amended Transit Element of the Baton Rouge Metropolitan Planning Organization's FY 2019 – FY 2022 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The changes below were approved by the Capital Region MPO Policy Committee on September 16, 2020.

FY 2018 – FTA 5307

- Repurpose \$300k federal funds of carryover previously programmed for Generators to Microtransit/Purchased Transportation.

FY 2020 – FTA 5307

- Decreasing funding for Systems Planning from \$1.14m federal to \$480k federal.
- Eliminating the COA line item and repurposing the \$1.42m federal funds to Microtransit, Shelters and Kiosks, and Operating Assistance.
- Repurpose \$240k federal funds for System Planning to Support Vehicles.
- Repurpose \$240k federal funds for System Planning to Upgrade/Rehab Maintenance Facility.
- Repurpose \$180k federal funds for System Planning to Microtransit.
- Repurpose \$100k federal funds for COA to Microtransit.
- Repurpose \$360k federal funds for COA to Shelters and Kiosks.
- Repurpose \$963k federal funds for COA to Operating Assistance.

Please also see attached the FY 2019-2022 Transit TIP projects, which will replace the previous version in its entirety. The new amendments will support the regional TAM targets set by CRPC (MPO) in coordination with LADOTD and CATS. The percent of revenue vehicles and equipment that have met or exceeded their useful

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life will decrease there by making the operations more efficient. Timely processing by your office will be, as always, greatly appreciated. Please contact me if you have any questions or need additional information.
