Please accept these amendments to the Transit Element of the Regional Planning Commission's FY 23 Transportation Improvement Programs (TIP) for the New Orleans UZA for inclusion in the State Transportation Improvement Plan.

In the New Orleans Urbanized Area, RTA has received Low or No Emissions Competitive Grant funding that will be used for the Accelerating Zero-Emissions Mobility for a Resilience New Orleans project to procure 20 zero-emission vehicles and install charging infrastructure. Funds will also be used to provide a microgrid to support charging resiliency after numerous major storms, re-tool the maintenance program, and staff training. There has also been a small adjustment to FY18 5307 funds that RTA will use for Paratransit and On-Demand Vehicles.
